## **Pastor Tony Macomson**

Pastor Tony Macomson is the son of the late Euty Lee Macomson and the late Wilbert Lee Lewis. One of six children, he graduated from Broome High School, Spartanburg, SC, and furthered his education at Spartanburg Methodist College. He received his associate's degree and completed his undergraduate degree at Limestone University, Gaffney, SC. He completed his degree in ministerial training at Fruitland Baptist Bible College, Hendersonville, NC. Dedicated to equipping himself for full-time ministry, he studied at Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary, Wake Forest, NC. He served as Pastor of Greater Zion Baptist Church, Spartanburg, SC, and Assistant Pastor at Mt. Calvary Baptist Church, SC, before being installed in 1980 as the Pastor of Suck Creek Baptist Church, where he continues to serve faithfully. In 2003 God sent another flock for whom he serves as Pastor of New Fellowship Baptist Church in Wellford, SC.

Pastor Macomson has been actively involved in numerous religious, civic, educational, and community organizations. His affiliations have included: the Cherokee County Black Ministerial Alliance, Moderator Emeritus of the Thickety Mountain Baptist Association, Gaffney, SC, the Greater Spartanburg Ministerial Alliance, President of the Fellowship Ministry of Gaffney, member of the Broome High Improvement Board, SC Notary, President and Founder of the Cowpens Black Historical Committee, and the Deputy Chaplain at Spartanburg Regional Medical Center.

For over four decades, Pastor Macomson has been committed to preaching the Gospel, serving God's people, and strengthening the communities where he has been called to lead. His life and ministry continue to be a testament to faithful leadership, unwavering dedication and a deep love for Christ and His Church.

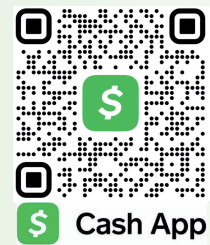
