Prayer Guide: Women's Conference -2025

Purpose of the Prayer Guide:

This prayer guide is designed to prepare the hearts of the women of God in Christ and to intercede for those who will receive salvation during and after the conference. Through these focused prayers, we seek to glorify God, acknowledge His love, grace, and justice, and embrace the season of open heavens.

Objectives of the Prayer Guide:

1. Salvation for the Lost:

To intercede for those who do not yet know Christ, that their hearts will be opened to receive salvation and experience the transforming power of the Gospel.

2. Strength and Spiritual Growth for Women of God:

To pray for the women of God to grow stronger in their faith, to walk boldly in their divine calling, and to be equipped for every good work in Christ Jesus.

3. Revealing God's Glory:

To pray that God's presence and power will be manifested during the conference, drawing many into a deeper relationship with Him.

4. Open Heavens and Divine Favor:

To declare and believe for the open windows of heaven, releasing divine favor, blessings, and breakthroughs in the lives of the women of God and those seeking Christ.

5. Unity and Corporate Anointing:

 To cultivate a spirit of unity among the women of God, creating an atmosphere where the Holy Spirit moves freely and lives are forever changed.

6. Empowerment for Evangelism:

 To pray that women of God will be empowered to share the Gospel with boldness and love, leading others to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Prayer Schedule:

- Pray twice daily—morning and evening—using the prayer points for each day.
- Join a corporate prayer call once a week for three weeks leading up to the conference to intercede together and strengthen our unity in Christ (To Be Determine).

Women's Conference Theme

Theme of Conference: "The Upward Call: Pressing Into God's Purpose with Power"

(Philippians 3:13-14)

Day 1 Sub-theme: "Breaking Free: Leaving the Past Behind to Embrace the New"

- Releasing past failures, disappointments, and wounds to walk in freedom
- Surrendering to God's healing and restoration
- Shifting from a mindset of regret to one of faith and expectation

Key Scriptures:

- •Isaiah 43:18-19 "Remember ye not the former things, neither consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert."
- •2 Corinthians 5:17 "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."
- •Psalm 91:1-2 "He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust."

Day 2 Sub-theme: "Stretching Forward: Aligning with God's Divine Purpose"

- Walking in obedience to God's plan with unwavering trust
- Strengthening spiritual discipline and deepening intimacy with Christ
- Overcoming distractions to stay focused on the path God has ordained

Key Scriptures:

• Jeremiah 29:11 – "For I know the thoughts that I think

toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end."

•**Hebrews 12:1-2** – "Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith."

- Psalm 23:1-3 "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake."
- •1 Peter 5:10 (NKJV) "But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.

Day 3 Sub-theme: "The Prize of His Presence: Finishing Strong in the High Calling of Christ"

- Pressing beyond obstacles with unshakable faith
- Living with an eternal perspective, seeking God's Kingdom first
- Running the race with endurance to receive the incorruptible crown

Key Scriptures:

- •2 Timothy 4:7-8 "I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing."
- •1 Corinthians 9:24-25 "Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain. And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible."
- Psalm 24:3-4 "Who shall ascend into the hill of the Lord? or who shall stand in his holy place? He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully."

This theme and sub-themes set the foundation for spiritually
